



INFORMATION ON THE THREE AAC ANNUAL EXHIBITS AT THE BUCKHEAD LIBRARY

Every May, October and December, the Atlanta Artist Center (AAC) has special exhibits at the Buckhead Library. All are multi-artist exhibits and artists must be current AAC members to participate.

1. These exhibits are not juried and there is no entrance fee.
2. The deadline to enter "information only" for each of these three AAC exhibits is one month before the exhibits are installed. The website for the entrance information is accessible a month before the information deadline.
3. The information is entered online at a specified website.
4. Art work is then brought to AAC during a specified period of 10-14 days after the information deadline.
5. All sales go through AAC. AAC retains 20% of the sales price and the artist receives 80%.
6. For receptions to these three exhibits, contributing artists may either bring something for the reception or donate \$10.00.
7. For artists wanting to enter an image for the poster contest, they attach it to the online entrance website or send to aacdamato@gmail.com. Image needs to be a jpeg file sized around 4x5, 4x6 at 96 dpi. The poster winner will then be asked for a larger sized file.
8. Artists also need to send a self photo and an artist bio, statement, and/or resume (whatever the artist wants the public to see).
9. The number of pieces accepted from each artist depends on the number of artists entering the exhibit.
10. Submitted work for all three exhibits needs to be framed according to AAC standards with wire on the back. Wrap around gallery canvases do not need to be framed but do need to be wired..

May is for all types of arts - painting, pastel, drawing, photography, sculpture, jewelry, collage, etc. Deadline to enter is on or before April 1 of each year.

October is for Photography and is part of Atlanta Celebrates Photography (ACP). The deadline to sign up for this exhibit is on or before September 1. Artists wanting their name in the ACP Information Booklet needed to send \$10.00 made out to "**AAC**" to Cheryl D'Amato by May 20. They should add a sticky note with the check stating exactly how they want their name listed or circle their name on their check. AAC Artists not in the ACP booklet may still be part of this exhibit by contacting Cheryl by the September 1 deadline. This exhibit was started by Cheryl D'Amato in 2005.

December is the Plein Air Painters Exhibit. The deadline for entering this exhibit is on or before November 1. "Plein Air" means "fresh air" and paintings for this exhibit need to be painted primarily outside. This exhibit was started by Nancy Hunter in 2005.

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
